WHEREAS, academic experience is vital to one's success, pointing to a need for adequate study spaces that meet the needs of SMUMN students; and,


WHEREAS, the student body has indicated interest and purpose in the proposal via the collection of 25 signatures in support of the project.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the office of Procurement be notified of this resolution immediately following its passage; and,


