 - Drivers can go up to four blocks off the route for a scheduled deviation
 - Deviations must be scheduled by calling 507-454-6666
- Services Availability
 - Dial A Ride
 - \$3.50 per person/ride and 10 ride punch cards are available
 - Monday Friday 6 am-6 pm
 - Saturday 9 am-5 pm
 - Call 507-353-6666
- All Winona transit buses comply with ADA and are equipped with wheelchair lifts
- Drivers can not assist with packages or bags
- Winona Transit is funded by the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT)
- Monthly passes, single ride tokens, and punch cards for other services are available at City Hall
- The bus that comes to Saint Mary's comes every 30 minutes.
- If you wanted to go downtown, you would either take the yellow bus or the green bus. Both of these busses cover all of the

 - \$3,000 a year for a contract
- The safe ride bus was Thursday-Saturday nights before COVID
 - 6 pm-1 am
 - Continually running two/three buses during these times
