Executive Board:

- President: Presides over all senate meetings, writes agendas, appoints
 members to committees, is a non-voting member with full floor privileges,
 member of MAPCS, attends MAPCS meetings, schedules executive board
 meetings, creates a strong student senate presence within the campus as a
 whole.
- VP of Academic Affairs: ensures student representation on all academic committees that seek a student opinion, serves on the Education Standards Committee, and the Curriculum Committee, meets with the Dean of students regularly, and serves as a liaison between the Student Success Center and the Student Senate.
- VP of Financial Affairs: responsible for budgeting and oversight of the funds derived from the student activity fee, chairs the Student Senate
 Finance Committee, and makes timely reports on the financial situation of the student activities fee to the President of the Student Senate.
- VP of Public Affairs: engages the undergraduate student body on the Winona Campus and the Student Senate in local and state politics, is the primary liaison between the University's Winona Campus and MAPCS, serves as a member of the MAPCS Advisory Board and is required to attend all MAPCS meetings, the liaison between the Student Senate and the Admissions Office and Alumni Office of the university, makes the Winona Campus aware of community events occurring in Winona County, serves as co-chair of the Student Senate Public Relations Committee, Facilities Committee, and Ethics Committee.
- VP of Student Affairs: works with departments and administration on issues regarding student affairs, addresses concerns dealing with the Wellness Center, residence life, student life, student activities, intramurals, food service, and the bookstore, co-chairs the Student Senate Student Life

- Committee, assists all interested clubs in becoming a Student Senate recognized organization.
- VP of Campus Affairs: Works with departments and administration on issues regarding campus affairs, sits on the Winona Campus Safety Committee, sits on the University Facilities Committee, addresses concerns dealing with maintenance, campus safety, and parking on campus, will co-chair the Student Senate Facilities committee, and oversee's the process of Student Senate capital improvements.
- VP of Media and Communications: the chief graphic designer of the Student Senate, responsible for public relations issues, elections, and advertising. Creates, updates, and manages the Student Senate's social media and website presence. The liaison between the Student Senate and the Marketing and Communications Office of the university. The liaison between the Student Senate and the IT Helpdesk of the university. Coordinates the Student Senate elections in conjunction with the President of the Student Senate. Co-chair the Student Senate Public Relations Committee.
- VP of Multicultural Affairs: be the student chair of the Solidarity Council which is responsible for representing and advocating for diversity and diversity initiatives on the Winona Campus including but not limited to diversity-related clubs, the International Student Center, and the Study Abroad office. Liaison between the Student Senate and the First Generation Initiative of the university. Liaison between the Student Senate and the International Center of the university. Liaison between the Student Senate and the Study Abroad Office of the university.
- VP of Administrative Affairs: Records and submits the minutes of each session of the Student Senate to the advisor and the Student Senate
 President for publication. Is responsible for all Student Senate documents.

Records Senator absences from a session of the Student Senate. Co-chairs the Student Senate Ethics Committee.

Class Officers: Advocates and fundraises for their graduating class, has voting privileges on the Senate Floor, and is a member of a Student Senate Committee.

Hall Representatives: Advocates for their residence hall/area, has voting privileges on the Senate Floor, and is a member of a Student Senate Committee.

At-Large Representative: Advocates all the whole student body including commuter students, has voting privileges on the Senate Floor, and is a member of a Student Senate Committee.

IHM Representative: Advocates for the Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary students, has voting privileges on the Senate Floor, and is a member of a Student Senate Committee.

International Student Representative: Advocates for international students, has voting privileges on the Senate Floor, and is a member of a Student Senate Committee.
